HALF DAY CITY TOUR, INCLUDING THE ACROPOLIS MUSEUM</b> <b>From 08.30 to 13.00</b> Visit of the Acropolis, the Acropolis Museum and sightseeing tour of the Parliament house, the tomb of the Unknown soldier, Hadrian's Arch, the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the Stadium, the Presidential Palace, the Academy, the University and the National Library.	83,00	62,00
<b>2. ATHENS BY NIGHT - From 20.15 to 00.30</b> Your evening will start with a short panoramic drive to the city centre of Athens. Then a pleasant walk to Plaka, the old part of Athens, for dinner in a typical Greek tavern with bouzouki music and Greek folk dances.	68,00	48,00
<b>3. CAPE SOUNIO (HALF DAY) – From 15.00 to 19.00</b> Drive along the Apollo coast, passing the wonderful beaches of Glyfada, Vouliagmeni and Varkiza, on the way to Cape Sounio to visit the temple of Poseidon. Return to Athens.	50,00	38,00
<b>4. HALF DAY TOUR TO ANCIENT CORINTH – From 08:45 to 14.00</b> Heading out to Ancient Corinth with short stop at Corinth Canal. Visit of the ancient town of Corinth, where St. Paul lived and preached for 2 years, the Agora and the pre Roman temple of Apollo. A short stop at the Site of the ancient port of Kehries where St. Paul disembarked. Return to Athens.	62,00	50,00
<b>5. ONE DAY DELPHI – From 08.30 to 18.45</b> Drive through the fertile plain of Boeotia, pass the towns of Thebes, Levadia and Arachova. Arrive at Delphi, the center of the Ancient world and visit the archaeological site and the Museum. Return to Athens by the same route. <b>7a. Lunch included during tour</b> <b>7b. <b>6. ONE DAY ARGOLIS – From 08.30 to 18.45</b> A visit to the Argolis region. Drive by the coastal road along the Saronic Gulf. Short stop at Corinth Canal. Proceed to Mycenae and visit the Lion Gate, the Tomb of Agamemnon and the Palace. Proceed to Nauplia and then to Epidaurus and visit the ancient theatre famous for its acoustics. <b>7. TWO DAYS DELPHI – From 08.30 to 18.30 (2<sup>nd</sup> day)</b> 1 <sup>st</sup> day: Leave Athens via the National highway, passing by Thebes, Levadia (short stop), Arachova. Visit the Museum of Delphi and the archaeological site. Free lunch. Afternoon free. Overnight Delphi. 2 <sup>nd</sup> day: Morning free in Delphi. Lunch free and return to Athens <b>9a. Overnight Nauplia  2<sup>nd</sup> day: Morning free in Nauplia. Lunch free and proceed to Epidaurus and visit the ancient theatre. Return to Athens.  <b>11a. Depart for Kalambaka crossing the central part of mainland. Dinner / Overnight.  2<sup>nd</sup> day: Visit Meteora monasteries containing priceless historical and religious treasures. Return to Athens via Trikala and Thermopile (short stop to see across the road the monument of Leonidas)  <b>12a. Accommodation in A' Class Hotels – half board</b>  <b>12b. Dinner and overnight  3<sup>rd</sup> day: Visit some of the Byzantine monasteries containing priceless historical and religious treasures. On the way back to Athens short stop to Thermopile to see across the road the monument of Leonidas.  <b>13a. Accommodation in A' Class Hotels – half board</b>  <b>13b. <p><b>11. THREE DAYS CLASSICAL TOUR – From 08.15 to 18.30 (3<sup>rd</sup> day)</b>  1<sup>st</sup> day: Leave by the coastal road to the Corinth Canal (short stop). Drive and visit the theatre of Epidaurus, famous for its remarkable acoustics. Then proceed to the town of Nauplia (short stop). Drive to Mycenae and visit the archaeological site and the tomb of Agamemnon. Proceed to Olympia for dinner and overnight.  2<sup>nd</sup> day: In the morning visit of the archaeological site with the Sanctuary of Olympian Zeus, the ancient stadium and the archaeological museum. Then drive on through the plains of Eliad and Achaia until the magnificent bridge which is crossing the Corinthian Bay from Rion to Antirion. Dinner and overnight in Delphi.  3<sup>rd</sup> day: In the morning visit the archaeological site and the Museum. Then drive through the village of Arachova, renowned for its colorful rugs and carpets. Return to Athens via Levadia and Thebes. Arrive in Athens early in the evening.  <b>14a. <p><b>12. FOUR DAYS CLASSICAL TOUR &amp; METEORE – From 08.00 to 18.30 (4<sup>th</sup> day)</b>  1<sup>st</sup> day: Leave by the coastal road to the Corinth Canal (short stop). Drive and visit the theatre of Epidaurus famous for its remarkable acoustics. Then proceed to the town of Nauplia (short stop), drive to Mycenae and visit the archaeological site and the tomb of Agamemnon. Proceed to Olympia for dinner and overnight.  2<sup>nd</sup> day: In the morning visit the archaeological site with the sanctuary of Olympian Zeus the ancient stadium and the Museum. Then drive on through the plains of Eliad and Achaia until the magnificent bridge which is crossing the Corinthian Bay from Rio to Antirio. Dinner and overnight in Delphi  3<sup>rd</sup> day: Visit the Archaeological site and the Museum of Delphi. Depart for Kalambaka, a small town situated at the foot of the astonishing complex of Meteora, gigantic rocks. Dinner and overnight in Kalambaka.  4<sup>th</sup> day: Visit the Byzantine Monasteries containing priceless historical and religious treasure, return to Athens via Trikala, Lamia, Thermopile (short stop to see across the monument of Leonidas).
